Sept 14	Love God	Matthew 22:37 ³⁷ Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind." ³⁸ This is the greatest and first commandment.	X
Sept 15	Love God	Exodus 20:2-4 ² I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery; ³ you shall have no other gods before me. ⁴ You shall not make for yourself an idol, whether in the form of anything that is in heaven above, or that is on the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.	
Sept 16	Love God	1 John 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments.	X
Sept 17	Love God	Psalm 31:23-24 Love the LORD, all you his saints. The LORD preserves the faithful, but abundantly repays the one who acts haughtily. ²⁴ Be strong, and let your heart take courage, all you who wait for the LORD.	X
Sept 18	Love God	1 Peter 1:8-9 Although you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and rejoice with an indescribable and glorious joy, ⁹ for you are receiving the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.	
Sept 19	Love God	Psalm 119:48 I revere your commandments, which I love, and I will meditate on your statutes.

Sept 20	Love God	<p>1 John 4:19-20 ¹⁹We love because he first loved us. Those who say, "I love God," and hate their brothers or sisters, are liars; for those who do not love a brother or sister whom they have seen, cannot love God whom they have not seen.</p>	X
Sept 21	Love Neighbor	<p>Mark 12:31 ³¹The second (commandment) is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."</p>	X
Sept 22	Love Neighbor	<p>1 Corinthians 13:4-7 ⁴Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant ⁵or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; ⁶it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. ⁷It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.</p>	X
Sept 23	Love Neighbor	<p>John 13:35 ³⁵By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."</p>	X
Sept 24	Love Neighbor	<p>Luke 10:36-37 ³⁶Which of these three, do you think, was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of the robbers?" ³⁷He said, "The one who showed him mercy." Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."</p>	X
Sept 25	Love Neighbor	<p>James 2:15-16 If a brother or sister is naked and lacks daily food and one of you says to them, "Go in peace: keep warm and eat your fill," and yet you do not supply their bodily needs, what is the good of that?</p>

Sept 26	Love Neighbor	Matthew 5:44 But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.	X
Sept 27	Love Neighbor	John 15:3 ¹³ No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends.	
Sept 28	Vision/Commitment	Proverbs 29:18, KJV Where there is no vision, the people perish.	
Sept 29	Vision/Commitment	Philippians 3:13b-14 but this one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, ¹⁴ I press on toward the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus.	
Sept 30	Vision/Commitment	Malachi 3:10 ¹⁰ Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in my house, and thus put me to the test, says the LORD of hosts; see if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour down for you an overflowing blessing.	
Oct 1	Vision/Commitment	2 Corinthians 9:7-8 ⁷ Each of you must give as you have made up your mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. ⁸ And God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance, so that by always having enough of everything, you may share abundantly in every good work.	
Oct 2	Vision/Commitment	Galatians 6:9 ⁹ So let us not grow weary in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest time, if we do not give up.	X

Oct 3	Vision/Commitment	<p>Mark 12:42-44 ⁴²A poor widow came and put in two small copper coins, which are worth a penny. ⁴³Then he called his disciples and said to them, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the treasury. ⁴⁴For all of them have contributed out of their abundance; but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, all she had to live on."</p>	
Oct 4	Vision/Commitment	<p>Romans 12:1 ¹I appeal to you therefore, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.</p>	
Oct 5	Blessings	<p>Jeremiah 29:11 ¹¹For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the LORD, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope.</p>	X
Oct 6	Blessings	<p>James 1:17 ¹⁷Every generous act of giving, with every perfect gift, is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.</p>	X
Oct 7	Blessings	<p>Romans 8:38-39 ³⁸For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.</p>	X
Oct 8	Blessings	<p>Numbers 6:24-26 ²⁴ The LORD bless you and keep you; ²⁵ the LORD make his face to shine upon you, and be gracious to you; ²⁶ the LORD lift up his countenance upon you, and give you peace.</p>	X

Oct 9	Blessings	Luke 6:22 Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude you, revile you, and defame you on account of the Son of Man.	X
Oct 10	Blessings	1 Chronicles 4:10 ¹⁰ Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, "Oh that you would bless me and enlarge my border, and that your hand might be with me, and that you would keep me from hurt and harm!" And God granted what he asked.	
Oct 11	Blessings	Psalms 37:5 Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him, and he will act.	X
Oct 12	Learn	Matthew 11:29 ²⁹ Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.	X
Oct 13	Learn	James 1:5 ⁵ If any of you is lacking in wisdom, ask God, who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly, and it will be given you.	
Oct 14	Learn	Deuteronomy 11:18-19 ¹⁸ You shall put these words of mine in your heart and soul, and you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and fix them as an emblem on your forehead. ¹⁹ Teach them to your children, talking about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise.	X
Oct 15	Learn	Psalms 90:12 So teach us to count our days that we may gain a wise heart.	X
Oct 16	Learn	John 14:26 But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.

Oct 17	Learn	Colossians 3:16 ⁶ Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly; teach and admonish one another in all wisdom; and with gratitude in your hearts sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to God.	
Oct 18	Learn	Psalms 51:6 You desire truth in the inward being; therefore teach me wisdom in my secret heart.	X
Oct 19	Act	Ezra 10:4 ⁴ Take action, for it is your duty, and we are with you; be strong, and do it."	X
Oct 20	Act	James 2:18 ¹⁸ But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I by my works will show you my faith.	X
Oct 21	Act	Philippians 4:8-9 Whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. ⁹ Keep on doing the things that you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, and the God of peace will be with you.	
Oct 22	Act	1 John 3:18 ⁸ Little children, let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action.	X
Oct 23	Act	Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing.	
Oct 24	Act	Corinthians 3:12 ² Since, then, we have such a hope, we act with great boldness	X

Oct 25	Act	1 Peter 1:13 Therefore prepare your minds for action; discipline yourselves; set all your hope on the grace that Jesus Christ will bring you when he is revealed.	
Oct 26	Relate	Romans 12:5 (NLT) So it is with Christ's body. We are all parts of his one body, and each of us has different work to do. And since we are all one body in Christ, we belong to each other and each of us needs all the others.	
Oct 27	Relate	Genesis 2:18 ¹⁸ Then the LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper as his partner."	
Oct 28	Relate	Galatians 6:2 ² Bear one another's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.	X
Oct 29	Relate	Proverbs 17:17 ¹⁷ A friend loves at all times, and kinsfolk are born to share adversity.	X
Oct 30	Relate	Ephesians 5:21 ²¹ Be subject to one another out of reverence for Christ.	
Oct 31	Relate	Exodus 20:12 ¹² Honor your father and your mother, so that your days may be long in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.	
Nov 1	Relate	Romans 12:15 ¹⁵ Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep.	X
Nov 2	Evangelism	Matthew 28:19-20a ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you.

Nov 3	Worship	John 4:23 ²³ But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father seeks such as these to worship him.	
Nov 4	Community	Galatians 6:10 ¹⁰ So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us work for the good of all, and especially for those of the family of faith.	
Nov 5	Service	Philippians 2:4-5 ⁴ Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others. ⁵ Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus.	
Nov 6	Prayer	1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 ¹⁶ Rejoice always, ¹⁷ pray without ceasing, ¹⁸ give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.	X
Nov 7	Giving of Gifts	1 Peter 4:10 ¹⁰ Like good stewards of the manifold grace of God, serve one another with whatever gift each of you has received.	
Nov 8	Scripture	2 Timothy 3:16 ¹⁶ All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness	
Nov 9	What should the church be	Mark 12: 29-31 ²⁹ Jesus answered, "The first is, 'Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one; ³⁰ you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' ³¹ The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."	X

Nov 11	What should the church be	1 Corinthians 1:10 ¹⁰ Now I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you be in agreement and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same purpose.	
Nov 12	What should the church be	Ephesians 4:11-12 ¹¹ The gifts he gave were that some would be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, ¹² to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ	X
Nov 13	What should the church be	2 Corinthians 5:17 ¹⁷ So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!	X
Nov 14	What should the church be	Ephesians 4:15 ¹⁵ But speaking the truth in love, we must grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ	
Nov 15	What should the church be	Acts 2:46-47 ⁴⁶ Day by day, as they spent much time together in the temple, they broke bread at home and ate their food with glad and generous hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and having the goodwill of all the people. And day by day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.
